ProFlow Permeable Paver [™] warrants that at the time of sale by an authorised dealer, the components of the ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™] to be free of defects in material and workmanship for 20 years in accordance with the terms. This will cover material defects resulting in failure of the paver sets for residential and commercial applications. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS ISSUED IN LIEU OF EVERY OTHER EXPRESSED AND ALSO IMPLIED WARRANTIES, COUN-TING THE WARRANTY OF FITNESS, AS WELL AS EXPRESSLY OMITS LIABILITY FOR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

The terms of this warranty state that when used in applications and installed per ProFlow Permeable Paver [™]. manufacturer instructions and as suggested on the blacklocustlumber.com website, our Pro Flow Permeable Paver [™] setts are guaranteed to resist rot for 20 years from original purchase date.

This warranty does not cover damages from improper installation, abuse, alteration, disasters, misuse and treatment in manner other than as intended. This warranty does not cover costs of removal, installation, reinstallation, installation tools, and assumes no loss of use, liability for incidental or consequential damages. No claims shall be accepted for the following reasons: cupping, checking, splitting, twisting, shrinking, staining, warping, discoloration, mould, fungus, or insect attack. The design and build must include adequate permeability for rainwater storage. Documentation should be presented at time of claim showing that the grounds were designed and inspected by a licensed soil engineer who is licensed for install in paver location. Only permeable joint fillers are allowed. Cement, concrete, polymeric sand, or other non permeable joint fillers will void the warranty.

Any claims must be submitted in writing to ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™]. Material must be installed at location of original delivery address unless previously agreed upon in writing. Installation shall only contain paver setts purchased from an authorised ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™], unless previous written acceptance of notification is obtained from ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™] no later than 7 days from original purchase date. If jobsite is to contain permeable pavers from prior suppliers, post suppliers or mixed sources; prior jobsite photo documentation and verified written notification to ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™] shall be made stating that the paver setts to be warranted is in proximity to paver setts purchased from other suppliers. ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™]. reserves the right to have a representative inspect the material. Purchaser's sole remedy for any claim whatsoever, whether in contract, warranty, tort, or strict liability, arising from the use, storage, or possession of ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™]. paver failed to perform as warranted above, shall only be the replacement of the specific ProFlow Permeable Pavers [™]. paver that were affected.
